It has been the practice so grant recognition to schools for a limited period and souh recognition used to lapse on the expiry of that period unless such recognition was removed before the expiry of the period. This practice was based on rule 54(2) of the Delhi School Education Rules 1978. In civil writ Ho.888 of 1977 in the case of Digambar Jain Society, the Hentble Righ Court of Delhi delivered a judgment in 80-8-1979 holding rule 54(2) ultra vires of the Delhi School Education Act, 1973. The operational portion of the said judgement reads here as under:

> Thus on a very careful consideration of all the various provisions of the Act and Rules, I am of the epinion that Rule 54(2) is ultra vires of the Act, and Chat recognition orginally granted to the school was an absolute recognition at any rate, the recognition granted after \$1-19-78 mist. be treated as the absolute grant of recognition within the scope of Rule id. It must be deemed that the authority was satisfied that of some time the school will be able to fulfil the requirements and condition for grant of recognition and because of this satisfaction a provisional exemption was given to it and the school was recognised. This being so, the recognision and because of this satisfaction a provisional exemption was given to it and the make school was recognised. This being so, the recognition cannot be taken away from the school exception the ma ner . centemplated by section & Sub-Section (4) or (6)".

The Prescribed Authority (Administrator of Delhi-Lt. Governor) announced his judgement on 9-11-79 in the case of Appeal Houlds/ 39-C.A. in the case of Bahar Education Trust Vs. State as here under:

> "In view of the law laid down by the Delhi High Court in the case of Digambar Jain Society, it has been held, and I hold accordingly that the appellent school continued to be recognised school. In case the Director of Educations of the opinion that the school does not satisfy any one of the condition specified under sub-section (1) of Section 4, he will have to follow the procedure laid down under section (6) of section (4) read with rule 56. ×

In view of the above cited High Court Judgement and above quoted Pronouncement of the Prescribed Authority (Lt. Governor), recognition of no school shall lapse as specified under rule 54(2). Recognition once granted shall be absolute.

Hence no school will be deemed recognised for a limited period, no matter whether it was recognised prior to the commencement of the Act/Rules, 1978 or has been granted recognition thereafted. The School Managements are requested to ensure that statutory requirements governing recognition as laid down under Section 4(1) (a) to (f) of the Delhi Education Act, 1973 should be duly complied with and conditions prescribed under rule 50 of the Delhi School Education Rules, 1973 should be duly fulfilled as well as facilities specified under Rule 51 under the said rule should be duly provided to the School. Conditions already imposed governing recognition should be fulfilled and report thereof be submit to the undersigned through Zonal Education Officer. The Managements will also continue to comply with other relevant requirements of the Delhi School Education Act and Rules 1973 as applicable to their schools.

The District Deputy Directors and Zonal Education Officers are required to conduct through inspection from time to time on the information/ / of the above mentioned statutory requirements/conditions of recognition and keep a record thereof in the recognition fales. Deficiencies, if any, be pointed out to the Managements for removing the same within specified period under intimation to the undersigned. In case, any Management fails to fulfil the statutory requirements mentioned above, action should be taken for withdrawl of recognition of in accordance with the procedure laid down under sub-section (6) of Sec.4of the Act read with Rule 56 of Delhi School Education Rules, 1973.
