Sir,

With reference to your letter No.7/13/Edn/59 dated the 29th July 1959 and 22/8/59 dated the 26th October 1959 on the subject cited above, I am directed to inform you that the Director of Education has been pleased to accord Provisional Recognition to your school w.e.f. 1.1.1960 to 31.12.60 in the first instance under the European Education Code, subject to the fulfilment of following conditions.

1. that any change in syllabi or rates of tuition fees etc. would be made with the approval of the department.
2. that the school managing committee will have two nominees of the department.
3. that the school will be open to inspection and will abide by the instructions issued by the department from time to time.
3. that the school will introduce standard Provident Fund for all the members of the staff who are confirmed.
5. that the termination of services of any employee except ~~one~~ one appointed in a leave vacancy or for a period of less than six months would be done with the approval of the department.
6. that the teachers are engaged on a written agreement in which the conditions of service are clearly defined and in which provision is made for payment of salaries during the vacation.
7. that the school will maintain all registers and records as specified in chapter 5 of European Punjab Education Code.
8. that the school authorities would create the necessary reserve fund within ~~three~~ <sup>one</sup> years. On an enrolment of 501 to 750 a reserve fund of Rs.12000/- is necessary.

You are however requested kindly to apply for extension in recognition at least two monts before

Sr/Madan,

It has been the practice to grant recognition to schools for a limited period and such recognition used to lapse on the expiry of that period unless such recognition was renewed before the expiry of the period. This practice was based on rule 54(2) of the Delhi School Education Rules 1978. In civil writ No.888 of 1977 in the case of Digambar Jain Society, the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi delivered a judgement on 30-8-1978 holding rule 54(2) ultra vires of the Delhi School Education Act, 1973. The operational portion of the said judgement reads here as under:

"Thus on a very careful consideration of all the various provisions of the Act and Rules, I am of the opinion that Rule 54(2) is ultra vires of the Act, and ~~therefore, the recognition granted to any school under this rule is null and void.~~ It must be deemed that the authority was satisfied that of some time the school will be able to fulfil the requirements and condition for grant of recognition and because of this satisfaction a provisional exemption was given to it and the school was recognised. This being so, the recognition and because of this satisfaction a provisional exemption was given to it and the school was recognised. This being so, the recognition cannot be taken away from the school except in the manner contemplated by Section 4 Sub-Section (4) or (6)".

The Prescribed Authority (Administrator of Delhi-Lt. Governor) pronounced his judgement on 9-11-79 in the case of Appeal No.142/C.A. in the case of Bahar Education Trust Vs. State as here under:

"In view of the law laid down by the Delhi High Court in the case of Digambar Jain Society, it has been held, and I hold accordingly that the appellant school continued to be recognised school. In case the Director of Education of the, opinion that the school does not satisfy any one of the condition specified under sub-section (1) of Section 4, he will have to follow the procedure laid down under section (6) of section (4) read with rule 56."

In view of the above cited High Court Judgement and above quoted Pronouncement of the Prescribed Authority (Lt.Governor), recognition of no school shall lapse as specified under rule 54(2). Recognition once granted shall be absolute.

Hence no school will be deemed recognised for a limited period, no matter whether it was recognised prior to the commencement of the Act/Rules, 1978 or has been granted recognition thereafter. Henceforth all recognised schools shall be deemed to be permanently recognised and recognition could be withdrawn only through the procedure laid down under sub-sec.(6) of Section (4) of the Act read with Rule 56 of Delhi School Education Rules, 1978.

The School Managements are requested to ensure that statutory requirements governing recognition as laid down under Section 4(1) (a) to (f) of the Delhi Education Act, 1978 should be duly complied with and conditions prescribed under rule 50 of the Delhi School Education Rules, 1978 should be duly fulfilled as well as facilities specified under Rule 51 under the said rule should be duly provided to the School. Conditions already imposed governing recognition should be fulfilled and report thereof be submit to the undersigned through Zonal Education Officer. The Managements will also continue to comply with other relevant requirements of the Delhi School Education Act and Rules 1978 as applicable to their schools.

The District Deputy Directors and Zonal Education Officers are required to conduct through inspection from time to time on the information/ / of the above mentioned statutory requirements/conditions of recognition and keep a record thereof in the recognition files. Deficiencies, if any, be pointed out to the Managements for removing the same within specified period under intimation to the undersigned. In case, any Management fails to fulfil the statutory requirements mentioned above, action should be taken for withdrawal of recognition of in accordance with the procedure laid down under sub-section (6) of Sec.4 of the Act read with Rule 56 of Delhi School Education Rules, 1978.
