With reference to your letter No.7/13/Edn/59 dated the 29th July 1959 and 22/8/59 dated the 26th October 1959 on the subject cited above, I am directed to inform you that the Director of Education has been pleased to accord Provisional Recognition to your school w.e.f. 1.1.1960 to 31.12.60 in the first instance under the European Education Code, subject to the fulfilment of following conditions.

- 1. that any change in syllabi or rates of tuition fees etc. would be made with the approval of the department.
- 2. that the school managing committee will have two nominees of the department.
- 3. that the school will be open to inspection and will abide by the instructions issued by the department from time to time.
- that the school will introduce standard Provident Fund for all the members of the staff who are confirmed.
- 5. that the termination of services of any employee except wer one appointed in a leave vacancy or for a period of less than six months would be done with the approval of the department.
- 6. that the teachers are engaged on a written agreement in which the conditions of service are clearly defined and in which provision is made for payment of salaries during the vacation.
- 7. that the school will maintain all registers and records as specified in chapter 5 of European Punjab Education Code.
- 8. that the school authorities would create the necessary reserve fund within years.
 On an enrolement of 501 to 750 a reserve fund of Rs.12000/- is necessary.



It has been the practice so grant recognition to schools for a limited period and scuh recognition used to lapse on the expiry of that period unless such recognition was renewed before the expiry of the period. This practice was based on rule 64(2) of the Delmi School Education Rules 1978. In civil writ No.288 of 1977 in the case of Digambar Jain Society, the Heatble High Court of Delhi delivered a judgment to 30-8-1979 holding rule 64(2) ultra vires of the Delmi School Education Act, 1978. The operational portion of the said judgement reads here as under:

> Thus on a very careful consideration of all the various provisions of the Act and Rules, I am of the opinion that Rule 64(2) is ultra vires of the Act, and Distriction

was satisfied that of some time the school will be able to fulfil the requirements and condition for grant of recognition and because of this section is a section. tion and because of this satisfaction a provintenal exemption was given to it and the school was recognised. This being so, the recognision and because of this satisfaction a provisional exemption was given to it and the weke achool was recognised. This being so, the recognitioncannot be taken away from the school exception the ma nor centemplated by section 4 Sub-Section (4) or (6)".

The Prescribed Authority (Administrator of Delhi-Lt. Governor) mounced his judgement on 9-11-79 in the case of appeal Holl48/ Jac. A. in the case of Bahar Education Trust Vo. State as here under:

> "In view of the law laid down by the Delhi High Court in the case of Digambar Jain Society, it has been hold, and I hold accordingly that the appellent school continued to be recognised school. In case the Director of Educations of the opinion that the school does not satisfy any one of the condition specified under sub-section (1) of Scetion 4, he will have to follow the procedure laid down under section (6) of section (6) read with rule 56. N

In view of the above cited High Court Judgement and above quoted Pronouncement of the Prescribed Authority (Lt. Governor), recognition of no school shall lapse as specified under rule 54(2). Recognition once granted shall be absolute.

Hence no school will be deemed recognised for a limited period, no matter whether it was recognised prior to the commencement of the Act/Rules, 1978 or has been granted recognition thereafter. forth all recognised schools shall be deemed to be permanently recognised and recognition could be withdrawn only through the procedure laid down under sub-sec.(6) of Section (A) of the Act rend with Rule 56 of Pelhi. School Education Rule 1978.

The School Managements are requested to ensure that statutory requirements governing recognition as laid down under Section 4(1) (a) to (f) of the Delhi Education Act, 1978 should be duly complied with and conditions prescribed under rule 50 of the Delhi School Education Rules, 1978 should be duly fulfilled as well as facilities specified under Rule 61 under the said rule should be duly provided to the School. Conditions already imposed governing recognition should be fulfilled and report thereof be subult to the undersigned through Zonal Education Officer. Managements will also continue to comply with other relevant requirements of the Delhi School Education Act and Rules 1978 as

The District Deputy Directors and Zonal Education Officers are required to conduct through inspection from time to time on the information/ / of the above mentioned statutory requirements/conditions of recognition and keep a record thereof in the recognition fales. Deficiencies, if any, be pointed out to the Managements for removing the same within specified period under intimation to the undersigned. In case, any Management fails to fulfil the statutory requirements mentioned above, action should be taken for withdrawl of recognition of in accordance with the procedure laid down under sub-section (6) of Sec. 4of the Act read with Rule 56 of Delhi School Education Rules, 1978.
